At last week's meeting, Daniel Wood from LT McGuiness outlined the construction timeline for the new airport terminal and gave a progress report.

The first phase was the construction of a temporary building and phase 2, the left side housing baggage handling and room for future screening is well under way. The final phase entailing replacing the temporary building with a new arrivals hall will see the \$43m project completed.

Daniel also said his company was proud of the fact that 88% of the demolition materials from the existing terminal were able to be recycled with concrete, timber, gib and steel all diverted from landfill and turned into new products.

Bob's talk was how important education is and the opportunities it can lead to.
