The club has received the following from Brodie. You may remember we recently contributed \$2500 towards his trip to the World Junior Squash champs in Egypt

To Papaioea Rotary Club,

I would like to thank you for your generosity and support to help get me to Egypt to represent New Zealand to compete in the World Junior individual and teams Squash Championships 2025. This event is the biggest highlight to date in my squash playing journey. I travelled from Auckland with the rest of the New Zealand team to Cairo where we had three days of adjusting to time zones and very hot temperatures before competing in the individual Championships. I played four matches, playing competitors from Germany, Portugal, Poland and England. I won two and lost two, getting me through to the quarter finals of the Plate section. This was the second highest finisher of the six New Zealand boys that competed. This event was won by Mohammed Zakaria from Egypt who is also currently ranked number 14 in the world for men.

After a day rest we began the World Junior teams
Championship. We played
Poland and U.S.A in our pool
play and lost both matches.
Moving on to the playoff
rounds we played Ireland,
Brazil and South Africa with our
New Zealand team finishing 16th.



I am happy with how I played, how I improved, I have learned and I have come back with things to work on so I now look forward to working towards future successes,

I once again thank you for your support which helped provide me an opportunity to test my abilities, an opportunity I value immensely.
